The 1966 FIFA Football World Cup final between England and West Germany went into extra-time after Wolfgang Weber scored a last-minute equaliser for West Germany. England restored their lead through Geoff Hurst's second goal 11 minutes into the first half of extra-time. The English players hung on by the skin of their teeth as the Germans threw all their players forward piling on the pressure on England's defence. As the minutes turned into seconds, the England fans' nerves and patient got to breaking point and some of them began to stream into the pitch with 45 seconds to go. Then Kenneth Wolstenholme, BBC commentator, uttered that famous line "they think it's all over..." A few seconds later Sir Geoffrey Charles Hurst MBE completed his hattrick to give England a 4-2 win over West Germany. Geoff Hurst still holds the record of the only man to ever score a hat-trick in a Football World Cup final!

That tournament holds a great deal of plots that reminds me of the Crucifixion and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The Jewish leaders of the day thought they had check mated our Lord Jesus when they had Him Crucified by the Roman Legion. The powers of hell would never have baited Judas and the elders of Israel into condemning and crucifying The Messiah!
