## The Barley Loaf Boy

"There is a lad here who has five barley loaves and two small fish, but what are they among so many?"

John 6:9 (NKJV)

After a day of miracles; of challenge to His authority and life by a lynch mob (John 5:8-18), and gruesome death of His cousin John the Baptist (Matthew 19:9-14), Jesus sort for a deserted place on a mountain for solitude. However, a crowd of over 5,000 people who had witnessed His miracles of healing were hot on His heels.

Look at what came out of five barley loaves and their condiments when they were placed in the hands of Jesus:

- ♣ 5,000 hungry men (not counting women and children) where fed (Matthew 6:21). If you go by today's church demography, you could say about 15,000 – 20,000 souls were fed!
- 12 Baskets of bread was left over! (John 6:12-13)
- ➡ The eyes of the people opened to see Jesus as the "Prophet to come" (Messiah) (John 6:14)
- ♣ The people wanted to forcefully make Jesus King of Israel! (John 6:15)

So it shall be for your children as you surrender them to God and serve Him with all you have: Unimaginable number of people will be blessed through your meagre strength. Your offering will be multiplied unto you. The generation of your children will testify that Jesus is indeed The Lord and they will submit to His Kingship.
